



In his inaugural speech on board the flagship Gotthard on lake Lucerne, Switzerland, Maharishi Ji said "It is through the window of science that we see The Dawn of the Age of Enlightenment".*

# जीवनोत्सव

( ब्रह्मचारी गिरीश जी अध्यक्ष, महर्षि विद्या मन्दिर विद्यालय समूह )

भारतीय संस्कृति में एक वर्ष को दो भागों में विभक्त किया गया है, जिन्हें हम दक्षिणायन एवं उत्तरायण के रूप में जानते हैं। इन्हें याम्यायन एवं सौम्यायन के नाम से भी जाना जाता है अर्थात् दक्षिणायन को याम्यायन एवं उत्तरायण को सौम्यायन कहते हैं। दक्षिणायन काल के व्यतीत हो जाने के उपरांत उत्तरायण का समय प्रारंभ होता है। उत्तरायण का प्रारंभ मकर संक्रांति से होता है अर्थात् सूर्य जब मकर राशि में प्रवेश करता है, तभी से उत्तरायण प्रारंभ हो जाता है। संक्रांति शब्द का अर्थ होता है, सूर्य का एक राशि से दूसरी राशि में प्रवेश करना।

**अग्निज्योतिरहः शुक्लः षण्मासा उत्तरायणम् । तत्र प्रयाता गच्छन्ति ब्रह्मविदो जनाः ॥**

यहाँ उत्तरायण को शुक्ल मार्ग से संबोधित किया गया है। शुक्ल मार्ग अर्थात् प्रकाश की बहुलता वाला मार्ग। नाम के अनुसार प्रकाश की बहुलता वाले मार्ग में यात्रा शुभदायक होती है, इसके विपरीत कृष्ण मार्ग अर्थात् अंधकार की बहुलता वाला मार्ग कष्टकारक होता है। अंधकार की बहुलता वाले मार्ग की यात्रा संघर्षपूर्ण होती है। अतः हमें भी स्वयं को अंधकार रूपी नकारात्मकता से प्रकाश की ओर अर्थात् सकारात्मकता की ओर अग्रसर होने का प्रयास करना चाहिए। क्या हम भी अपने जीवन में संक्रांति को धारण करना चाहते हैं या तिल-गुड़ से बने मिष्ठान ईश्वर को अर्पित कर स्वभोग लगाकर पतंग उड़ा कर उत्सव की इतिश्री कर लेंगे। सामान्यतः हम यही करते आये हैं। संक्रांति हमें सिखाती है कि हमारे जीवन का उत्तरायण हो रहा है या हम दक्षिणायन की ओर अग्रसर हैं। संक्रांति का शाब्दिक अर्थ है परिवर्तन, नवीनीकरण और प्रकृति की परिवर्तनशील शिक्षा का स्वागत करना। यह हमें सिखाती है कि परिवर्तन शाश्वत है और इसका स्वागत करना चाहिये। जिस प्रकार ऋतुएँ बदलती हैं वैसे ही हमारे जीवन में भी परिवर्तन आते हैं जिन्हें हमें सहजता से स्वीकार करना चाहिए। सूर्य का दक्षिणायन से उत्तरायण हो जाना हमें जीवन में सदैव सकारात्मकता के साथ अपने लक्ष्यों को प्राप्त करने के लिए प्रेरित करता है। हमारे जीवन का आधार आध्यात्मिक साधना से उन्नति ही है। यह अवसर नवीन फसल के लिये सूर्य व प्रकृति एवं ईश्वर के प्रति आभार व्यक्त करने का समय है। यह हमें प्राप्त समस्त सुख-सुविधाओं के लिये आभारी एवं संतोषी होना सिखाता है और हमें निस्वार्थ भाव से दूसरों की सहायता करने एवं समाज में समरसता लाने के लिए प्रेरित करता है। यह उत्सव प्रकृति का उत्सव है जो हमें प्रकृति के महत्व को समझाते हुए उसके संरक्षण एवं संवर्धन के लिये प्रेरित व जीवन के प्रति प्रोत्साहित करता है। हमें इस अवसर पर स्वयं का आकलन करना चाहिये कि हमारी वर्तमान परिस्थिति भूतकाल से अच्छी है, तो निश्चित ही भविष्य में हमारी उन्नति आकर्षक होगी और यदि वर्तमान हमारे भूतकाल से कम संतोष दायक है, तो हमें हमारी वर्तमान परिस्थिति का आकलन सत्य की पराकाष्ठा पर कर स्वयं को अंधकार से प्रकाश की ओर ले जाने के लिए छोटे ही सही किन्तु प्रभावी प्रयास करने चाहिये क्योंकि हमारे जीवन की प्रत्येक परिस्थितियों के लिये सदैव हम ही उत्तरदायी हैं और यह सर्वविदित हो उसके पहले ही स्वयं की समस्त शक्तियों को संगठित कर स्वयं को आत्मिक रूप से सुदृढ़ बनाने के प्रयास में तुरंत ही लगना होगा। जितना शीघ्र हम स्वयं के सम्मोहन को त्याग कर सत्य का दर्शन करेंगे उतना शीघ्र ही हमारे जीवन में उन्नति की संक्रांति का उत्सव आयेगा। यह सच्चा जीवनोत्सव होगा जहाँ प्रतिदिन आनंद के सरोवर में सम्पन्नता एवं संतुष्टि का स्नान कर हम तृप्त हो जायेंगे। यही सच्चा आनंद है। परमपूज्य महर्षि महेश योगी जी सदैव कहते थे "जीवन आनंद है।"

# Maharishi Gyan Yug Diwas Celebration

To Complete Resolutions of Maharishi Ji is Our Resolution  
 : Brahmachari Girish Ji



Two-days "Age of Enlightenment Day" (Gyan Yug Diwas) celebration started in India and rest of the world on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2026 on 109<sup>th</sup> birthday of His Holiness Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Ji, the greatest scientist of Consciousness in the world. The main celebration was organised at Maharishi Utsav Bhavan, Bhopal under the divine guidance of Ved Vidya Martand Brahmachari Girish Ji, Hon'ble Chairman, Maharishi Group of Educational Institutions.



The event began with Shri Guru Parampara Poojan by Brahmachari Girish Ji who was joined by all present in Maharishi Utsav Bhavan. This was followed by Vedic Shanti Path chanted by Maharishi Vedic Pundits. Guests and dignitaries were welcomed to the stage, marking a day focused on combining ancient wisdom with modern ideas.

A high-level intellectual seminar titled "Establishing World Peace through Science and Technology" was organised on this day to mark the two-day Gyan Yug Diwas celebrations.

In the opening session, Brahmachari Girish Ji addressed the audience, paying tribute to Maharishi

Mahesh Yogi Ji and his historic contribution in promoting Vedic Science and Indian culture globally. He emphasized that today is a sacred and joyful day, celebrating the life of Maharishi Ji, who restructured and restored ancient Indian Vedic Knowledge and gifted the same to the world. He travelled to 124 countries, spreading Indian spirituality, Transcendental Meditation, and proudly representing India on the global stage.

Brahmachari Girish Ji expressed pride in being messenger of world peace under Maharishi Ji's guidance. He highlighted the importance of passing this spiritual wisdom to future generations. He also remembered Swami Vivekananda on his birthday, noting that both spiritual saints and leaders aimed to share Indian values globally in the interest of happy, healthy and peaceful life.

Brahmachari Girish Ji urged that today's global conflicts stem from powerful nations' expansionist mindsets. He recalled how Maharshi Ji used Vedic knowledge, principals and practical technologies of Yog and Yagyas to prevent wars and that his organization continues to seek world peace. He noted the rising negative influences in the world and suggested that divine intervention may be necessary once again. He highlighted Yog and Yagya as the true paths to peace and praised Indian Prime Minister Modi for promoting Yog and Meditation globally. He announced several new initiatives dedicated to his Guru, including the Maharishi World Peace Movement, Maharishi Ideal India Campaign and offered monthly E-Gyan-digital newsletter of Maharishi organisation, E-Newsletter of Maharishi World Peace Movement, Maha Media magazine, Gyan Ki Gagar part 3 (collection of editorials published in Maha Media Magazine), new year Panchang, Maharishi diary, table calendar and newsletter of Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Vedic Vishwavidyalaya (MMYVV), Karoundi, (M.P.).



In his speech, Prof. Promod Verma, Vice-Chancellor MMYVV noted that while science is often perceived as a modern discipline, it is not a separate entity in Indian scriptures; rather, it is deeply embedded within our Shastras.



He emphasized that our ancient knowledge encompasses everything from construction and medicine, to ethics, suggesting that science is simply the result of refining and focusing knowledge toward a specific objective. Prof. Verma further explored the role of science and technology in the quest for world peace, stating that science is essentially the pursuit of truth and an effort to understand the unknown mysteries of the universe. He drew a parallel between scientific inquiry and spiritual discovery, noting that while one seeks truth in the external world, the other seeks it within oneself. As per the Indian tradition, knowledge is divided into Apra Vidya, which governs the laws of manifest universe and Para Vidya, which governs the laws of un-manifest universe. He clarified that there is no conflict between the two; rather, they share the same ultimate goal of universal welfare.



Renowned DRDO Scientist Dr. Sudhir Mishra joined the seminar virtually to share his insights. He pointed out the irony of the current global situation, stating that while we discuss world peace, the powerful nations—the so-called superpowers—who bear the primary responsibility for maintaining peace, are often the ones disrupting

it. He noted that the prevailing geopolitical systems are a major source of widespread unrest. Dr. Mishra also shared a personal connection to the cause, mentioning that he was born in Jabalpur, the birthplace of Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Ji, and considers it his great fortune.



Dr. Niloy Khare, Advisor to the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, began his lecture by observing that happiness is a very difficult thing to achieve in today's world. He explained that a person's basic needs consist of food, water, air, money, and a healthy social ecosystem. He suggested that if we improve these dimensions through technical interventions, science and technology can greatly impact the life of the common man. Dr. Khare noted with concern that we have polluted our own air and water, and the effects of climate change are now being felt directly. He remarked that we frequently witness nature's retribution because of the negative contributions towards the environment by us. He believes that because humanity has acted selfishly, we have crossed a threshold where nature is now reacting to our past actions. He urged everybody to contribute positively for a safe environment.



Scientist and author Prof. Chetan Singh Solanki expressed his gratitude to Brahmachari Girish Ji for the invitation for participating in this divine seminar. He emphasized that climate change is no longer a future threat; it has already arrived. He appealed that everybody should understand the gravity of this crisis.

Prof. Solanki explained that the root cause of climate change is the rise in the Earth's temperature. He requested everybody to change their habits and adopt the principles-"Use Less, Reuse and Recycle" which was embedded in the daily routine of our all ancestors. Only this will save the planet from the onslaught of climate change.



Prof. Bhuvnesh Sharma former Vice-Chancellor of Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Vedic Vishwavidyalaya, extended warm greetings for Maharishi Ji's Birth Anniversary and "Gyan Yug Diwas" to all present including international guests from France, Vedic scholars, Ashtanga Yog educators, and Vedic Pundits. Prof. Sharma specifically expressed his gratitude to Brahmachari Girish Ji for his leadership and for facilitating the publication of the Hindi edition of his book.

Reflecting on the significance of Gyan Yug Diwas, Prof. Sharma explained that this day celebrates Maharishi Mahesh Yogi's contribution of providing the foundational knowledge of the entire creation to humanity. He emphasized that the various challenges and suggestions expressed by esteemed speakers during this seminar could find their ultimate resolution through Transcendental Meditation (TM) and application of

principles of Maharishi Vedic Science in their daily life. Guided by Maharishi Ji's mantra of "one solution to all problems," he highlighted that regular practice of TM awakens the Laws of Nature within one's own consciousness and fills his/her life with Bliss.



Vidya Shri Madhusudan Deshpande, Director of Maha Swasthya Shiksha Abhiyan, talked about the Ayurvedic work being done by Maharishi Sansthan.

Shri Deshpande presented the first three winners of the essay competition on Ayurved organised by MAHA.

Brahmachari Girish Ji awarded the winners.



Summarising today's deliberations, Brahmachari Girish Ji reminded everyone to share the knowledge we have gained today from the discussion and follow these teachings & apply them to one's own lives to help overcome personal challenges. Only then everyone will remain in Bliss forever. He emphasized that the regular practice of Transcendental Meditation is the key to overcoming all challenges.




