

Steeped in the experience of life being bliss and armed with the knowledge that the purpose of life is




the expansion of happiness Maharishi boldly announced at the start of his Spiritual Regeneration Movement 'I will fill the world with love and create heaven on earth'. After 18 short years of ceaseless activity teaching Total Knowledge around the world Maharishi's world plan was fulfilled and Maharishi could declare on 12 January 1975 on Lake Lucerne in Switzerland: 'Through the window of science we see the dawn of the Age of Enlightenment'.

We, the Governors, Sidhas and Meditators of Switzerland, nay the whole population of Switzerland, feel deeply touched and grateful to Maharishi Ji that he chose Switzerland as his residence for many years. Maharishi, the living expression of the almighty evolutionary force of nature, blessed Switzerland and from here the whole world with his immeasurable grandeur, royal dignity, and authority founded in the totality of the infinite organizing power of natural law. Maharishi silently reshaped the destiny

of the world and transformed the quality of time from the age of ignorance to the Age of Enlightenment – from a time of darkness, suffering, and problems to a glorious new civilization for all mankind, Heaven on Earth, Raam Raj.

In December 1974, scientific research studies showed that the crime rate had decreased in four cities with 1% of their population practising Transcendental Meditation. When Maharishi received that information he said, 'If the crime rate could go down in four cities, here is a formula to eliminate crime in every city – here is a formula for the Age of Enlightenment.' It was the discovery of the Maharishi Effect that inspired Maharishi to inaugurate the dawn of the Age of Enlightenment.



With great delight and profound gratitude we remember the countless hours Maharishi Ji spent in the large assembly hall in the International Capital of the

Age of Enlightenment in Seelisberg, Switzerland, on the stage with Vedic experts from India and scientists from around the world, in the audience 300 Teachers of Transcendental Meditation. On many occasions Maharishi Ji would gently spin the lighted globe next to him while revealing the new principles that guide life in the Age of Enlightenment. To us this simple gesture beautifully expressed Maharishi Ji's unbounded love and parental care for the world, his compassion for the restless and suffering humanity, his grand vision of a new fortune for the world, his complete dedication to fully apply the Total Knowledge and the

Vedic Technologies of Consciousness he received from Guru Dev Shankaracharya Swami Brahmananda Saraswati – to irreversible change the destiny of the world from the age of ignorance to the Age of Enlightenment. As a further important step to ensure the dawn of new knowledge Maharishi established in Switzerland in 1975 Maharishi European Research University – MERU – to study and conduct research in consciousness. Maharishi revived the total theoretical and practical knowledge of Yoga after thousands of years and introduced the Transcendental Meditation Siddhi Programme, including Yogic Flying, to accelerate the evolution of the individual to enlightenment and to purify world consciousness. Thousands of participants from around the world attended the courses of MERU in Switzerland.

Maharishi, in his perfect attunement with the infinite intelligence of nature, then felt the need for a new system of administration, based on natural law, to fulfil the requirement of the time. In 1976 Maharishi inaugurated on flagship Gotthard on Lake Lucerne in Switzerland the World Government of the Age of Enlightenment, with sovereignty in the domain of consciousness and authority in the invincible power of Natural Law, to raise world consciousness and guide the destiny of mankind.

"The World Government of the Age of Enlightenment is the realization of the most sublime aspiration of

the wise throughout the ages. It has arisen with the Dawn of the Age of Enlightenment, which was inaugurated by Maharishi on this lake on 12 January 1975 and on all five continents as the fulfillment of this World Plan, formulated in 1972 to eliminate the age-old problems of mankind in this generation.


Through the Science of Creative Intelligence, with its practical aspect,


Jai Guru Dev



In 1977 Maharishi inaugurated in Seelisberg, Switzerland, the ideal society campaign by sending Yogic Flyers to 108 countries. Wherever they went the police took the credit for lowering the crime rate. With this global success, Maharishi formulated his Absolute Theories of Government, Education, Health, Defence, Economy, Management, and Law and Order to raise every area of life to perfection.

Maharishi inaugurated the year 1978 in Seelisberg, Switzerland, as the Year of Invincibility to Every Nation and declared, "This celebration of Invincibility to Every Nation is a proof of rising purity in world consciousness, brought about by the Transcendental Meditation and TM-Siddhi programme. The world has changed.

The conches and bells and trumpets which, in the past, were sounded to announce preparedness for war, are now being blown and rung to announce Invincibility to Every Nation – to announce the end of wars, the end of conflicts, the end of fears, and the end of hostility in life. This celebration in the Assembly Hall of the World Government of the Age of Enlightenment – a hall which represents all nations at all times – symbolizes the awakening of the responsibility of every individual and nation towards the immortality of life. Life is immortal and invincible. It is bliss. The ringing of these bells of bliss crowns twenty-



one years of teaching Transcendental Meditation around the world to awaken the consciousness of the individual, to make it rise up and move and be active, and to demonstrate that invincibility lies at the deepest core of everyone's existence. Invincibility has always been the birthright of every nation, but it lay dormant. Now it will blossom on the surface of life."

With the discovery of the Extended Maharishi Effect in 1978, a formula was found to create coherence in collective consciousness and raise nations to invincibility through the square root of one per cent of the population practising the TM-Siddhi programme together; the requirement for 1% was now reduced to just



the square root of one per cent. Maharishi validated this formula by sending groups of Yogic Flyers to the most troubled spots on earth. Scientific research recorded the success.

A most unforgettable moment was for us all when in 1980 in Seelisberg Maharishi brought to light his timeless commentary of Rik Veda, the Apaurusheya Bhashya. Maharishi Ji explained that Total Knowledge and its infinite organizing power is completely contained, expressed, and demonstrated in the sequential enfoldment of the text of Rik Veda. The orderly, sequential

enfoldment of Rik Veda is available to anyone at any time, intellectually in the Apaurusheya Bhashya, and experientially in one's own Transcendental Consciousness through Transcendental Meditation. Maharishi's Apaurusheya Bhashya of Rik Veda explains that the Veda is its own complete commentary; Veda is the structure of complete knowledge, it is so complete that nothing is out of it – complete knowledge, complete organizing power, the whole universe is contained within the Veda; Veda is the structure of consciousness which is life eternal – Veda is structured in consciousness.

For about 10 years Maharishi Ji blessed Switzerland with his presence and during that time we were fortunate to witness again and again the two extreme ends of infinity fully lively in Maharishi: the infinite, unbounded, cosmic, universal value playing within the boundaries of individuality. When Maharishi spoke, his speech was the voice of nature in its absolute state; his movements were the Absolute in motion. In every word, gesture, and action of Maharishi, eternity flowed in the waves of time, and the unbounded ocean of bliss rose in endless waves of bliss and joy. Maharishi's dignity was gentle like the spring breeze enchanted with the fragrance of jasmine flowers, his love for the world was all encompassing and full of compassion. His whole being radiated the reality life – the birthright of everyone: "I am Totality - Aham Brahmasmi" and "This Self (Atma) is Totality, Wholeness (Brahma) Ayam Atma Brahma".

His Holiness Maharishi Mahesh Yogi created in the short period of just 50 years the unshakable foundation for an invincible world. And with great fulfilment Maharishi could declare on 11 January 2008: "The future of the world is bright, and that is my delight. It has been my pleasure at the feet of Guru Dev, to take the light of Guru Dev and pass it on in my environment. Now today, I am closing my designed duty to Guru Dev. And I can only say, Live long the world in peace, happiness, prosperity, and freedom from suffering. All Glory to Guru Dev. Jai Guru Dev."

No words can fathom Maharishi's unfathomable magnitude, perfection, brightness and grandeur. Guru Gita beautifully states:

Na Guroradhikam tattvam, na guroradhikam tapah /
Tattvam jnanaat param nasti, tasmai shri gurave namah //74 //

There is no truth higher than the Guru, no spiritual practice higher than service to him, No truth higher than the knowledge of him, I bow down to Shri Guru.

Ekam nityam vimalamachalam sarvadhi saakshi bhutam/ Bhaavaatitam tirguna rahitam sad gurum tam namaami// 89 //

I bow to that Sadguru who is the embodiment of Brahma and bliss, the bestower of ultimate happiness; who is absolutely alone, that IS – he is the only one who is unmatched, unlike any other. He is total knowledge personified. He is beyond all dualities and is omnipresent and infinite like the sky. He is the object of the Maha Vakyas like "Tat tvam asi". He is the only one, eternal, free form impurities, steadfast, the witness of everyone's intellect and he is beyond the mind and emotions. He is free from the three gunas.

Yasmaat parataram naasti, neti netiti vai shrutih/ Manasaa vachasaa chaiva, nityamaaraadhayet gurum//82 //

Nothing exists which is higher than him, the Vedas describe him as "not this, not this'.

Therefore always worship the Guru with mind and speech.

In great and profound gratitude towards the unbounded and unfathomable blessings of Maharishi Ji we become silent and unite with him in our own blissful self-referral consciousness.

India to Be the Supreme Power in the World

Maharishi's Address to Political Leaders of India (Actually meant for the political leaders of the world) 26 May 1986, Maharishi Nagar, India

I have great joy to express my very strong desire to make India the supreme power in the world; and this desire has at its basis our ability to do so.



We have the complete knowledge of that level of Natural Law, which is the invincible, eternal, immortal basis of all diversity, and that is the knowledge of the Veda.

The Veda is the structure of pure knowledge, which contains within itself the infinite organizing power of Natural Law. We have developed this knowledge and have amply verified that this pure knowledge, which has infinite creative potential, can be harnessed by the individual and by groups of individuals.

By enlivening this infinite organizing power of Natural Law in human awareness, it is completely within our grasp to create invincibility; and because our beautiful homeland, Motherland, India, is the perpetual seat of the Veda—*Veda Bhumi*, the Land of the Veda—it is unnatural for India to be anything less than perfect and invincible.

Whatever has been the case in the past, everyone is aware of it; we don't have to spend a moment on it. Today, fortunately, we have that practical knowledge of the full creative potential of Natural Law, which we can use to make India the supreme power in the world.

This idea comes from the need of our time. Time demands the rise of a supreme, invincible power in the world family, which can have authority over the superpowers.

This is the demand of the time, this is the requirement of today, because the dangerous rivalry of superpowers has kept the whole population of the world under fear for so many years in the past, and as the days go by, fear is mounting day by day.

We will analyze how and why there is a rise of these destructive powers in human existence on earth—why it happens. I say 'it happens'—it has been happening time after time.

Knowledge is Supreme Power

Age after age some destructive power rises in the world and has a sweeping influence of destruction over the whole human race. How many civilizations have changed hands; how many civilizations have come and gone over time? Why do these destructive powers have such a tremendous ability to overthrow the destiny of all mankind? The reason is ignorance.'

'Whenever human intelligence is in ignorance about its harmony, about its coherence, about its oneness with Cosmic Intelligence, then individual intelligence falls short of its nature.

The essential nature of human intelligence is Cosmic Intelligence. The simplest form of human awareness is on that level of Cosmic Intelligence which is the creator, the governor, and the maintainer of the whole cosmos; but when individual awareness is not aware of its dignity, of its enormous power, of its unboundedness, of

its invincibility, of its immortality, then it falls short of its nature; anything that is weak doesn't have much

If someone is weak, it is because he lacks the full support of Nature; he is out of the royal road of evolution.

The innate weakness of human intelligence—lack of knowledge about its own infinite, creative potential—is at the basis of all suffering—suffering results from the lack of knowledge that individual consciousness, individual intelligence, is enormous, unbounded, infinite, immortal, eternal, invincible. Lack of knowledge is at the basis of all weakness, and weakness is the basis of all suffering.

When the individual awareness is weak, in its weakness it must struggle to achieve anything. This is due to ignorance of the enormous capacity, infinite capacity, unbounded creativity of individual consciousness.

When one functions and one thinks or does anything without the full power of one's intelligence, then one is not using the total potential of one's own nature, and as the nature of the individual is essentially in perfect accord with Cosmic Intelligence, when he has forgotten the value of that enormous Cosmic Power, he remains weak because he is not making use of the full creative potential of Natural Law.

The individual will make use of the full creative potential of Natural Law when, and only when, he is aware of its enormous potentiality.

Awakened in one's own fullness, awakened in one's WHOLENESS, awakened in one's invincibility, immortality, eternity, unboundedness, one will spontaneously utilize the full creative potential of Natural Law; and not knowing that enormous, inherent invincibility within one's Self, one would always be spontaneously using only a part of Natural Law, which means that other aspects of Natural Law will be violated.

This is an important point to understand. Violation of Natural Law, violation of the Laws of Nature, is a punishable offence and therefore deserves suffering. As violation of national law deserves punishment from the government, so violation of Natural Law deserves punishment from Nature's Government.

When people are not educated to think and act spontaneously according to Natural Law, then invariably they are violating the Laws of Nature, and violation of Natural Law must result in stress in the whole environment. The accumulation of stress in the whole environment, due to the violation of the Laws of Nature by the whole population of the world, must contaminate and pollute the whole world consciousness. Pollution in world consciousness must create stress, and, when it goes beyond a certain limit of flexibility, elasticity, must burst into collective calamities; it bursts into wars, national and international conflicts, terrorism—all kinds of misfortunes.

Therefore, the basic cause of suffering in the world; the basic cause of wars in the world; the basic cause of the dangerous rivalry of the superpowers, which is creating mounting fear in the whole world's population; the basic cause of increasing terrorism in the world is the accumulation of stress caused by the violation of the Laws of Nature by the whole population of the world, simply because education does not train the people to spontaneously think and act according to Natural Law, This is a very important point that I am emphasizing: the cause of all suffering in life, the cause of all these national and international conflicts, the cause of all misfortunes in life—whether it is the life of the individual or the nation—is the violation of Natural Law, and the basic reason for this is education, which does not train the people to spontaneously think and act according to Natural Law, and therefore the whole world's population is violating the Laws of

Nature. Violation of Natural Law must result in accumulation of stress; accumulated stress must burst out into collective calamity.

Today the world is going through such a terrible time because the stress in world consciousness is fairly strong.'

Knowledge of Natural Law

Only the knowledge of the full creative potential of Natural Law, only the technology which will use this knowledge to educate man and train him to spontaneously think and act according to Natural Law—only this programme will be at the basis of permanent peace on earth.

Some people talk about world peace all the time, but the man on the street doesn't worry much about it because he knows that world peace can only be created by governments; naturally international conflict is only between governments.

When governments begin to conflict with each other, it's just an indication that the collective consciousness of their countries is under the grip of very strong stress caused by the violation of Natural Law by the whole population of the world.

Therefore, when we are thinking of making India an invincible nation—a supreme power in the world—it is on the basis of our ability to muster the invincible power of Natural Law and practically use it to make Indian national consciousness integrated.

There is a level in Nature which we know is completely invincible. This invincible level of Natural Law is within our grasp. It is the level of Natural Law which modern science calls the Unified Field of all the Laws of Nature and that is the level of Natural Law which our Vedic Science calls Samhita of Rishi, Devata and Chhandas. To elaborate on the nature of the Unified Field of the Samhita of Rik Veda is a subject by itself; we will deal with it later.

For our consideration of raising India to be the supreme power in the world it is enough for us, just at present, to take it for granted that there is a level of the total creative potential of Natural Law, and it is within our reach to use it.

Ideal Education

Goal of Quality Education:-

Nowadays whatever weaknesses, Health problems, behavioral problems, crime and other problems in society, all are due to lack of proper education. Ideal Education is expected to produce ideal citizens living life free from suffering, good in health, good in behavior, living happy life himself, creating harmony in the environment and contributing to society.

"Ideal Education should be capable of providing the fruit of all knowledge while the tree of knowledge is still growing: the student is fulfilled as he grows in the ability to think and act in accord with natural law, and live life free from mistakes and suffering. Contact with the source of all knowledge in his own awareness, together with the enjoyment of the fruit of all knowledge in daily activity, makes the student a master of life."

True education is not just giving the bundles of books and information about virtues and values in life but to culture the mind, body, intellect, speech and senses in such a manner that the individual lives life in enlightenment, free from mistakes, enjoying knowledge, power and bliss. The role of education is to culture the individual in such a manner that he himself lives blissfully and also contributes to the society in its progress and peace.

The real aim of education as stated above by His Holiness Maharishi Mahesh Yogi Ji is to enliven Total Knowledge in the conscious awareness of every student. What is meant by Total Knowledge is that there are innumerable laws of nature and modern science is also indicating that the silent level, the state of least excitation is the reservoir of the all laws of nature and by taking the awareness to that silent level, the level of "Samadhi" or the Transcendental state of Consciousness, the laws of nature become lively in the awareness of the individual. While modern education gives the knowledge of some parts of the laws of nature by teaching different disciplines to the students. That's why we see that even the so called educated people having many degrees in different disciplines are seen making mistakes in their own lives and also creating problems in the lives of society as a whole. With enlivening of all the laws of nature in his simplest form of awareness the individual will think and act in a more holistic manner and not from an isolated view एवल्पमप्यस्य धर्मस्य त्रायते महतो भयात् from a little bit of action in accordance with the laws of nature (Dharma) धर्म individual becomes free from the biggest of fears.

Tradition of Vedic Knowledge: India has the ancient tradition of enlivening Total Knowledge (Veda) in every student thereby creating the ability to act in accordance with the laws of nature spontaneously. Unfortunately from quite long time the technique to contact the reservoir of all the laws of nature in one's own awareness was either not used or lost, being under the rule of Mugals and British rulers and forgetting our own ideal ways of education. In the field of education instead of following our own path, India also started following the path of west, especially drifted and attracted by some partial technological advances bringing partial success to life while simultaneously creating many other problems for the individual, society and the whole environment also.

Ancient Vedic literature emphasizes on achieving the highest goal of education i.e. Self Realization. As Lord Krishna says in Bhagwad-Geeta "अध्यात्म विद्या विद्यानाम्", amongst the fields of education Knowledge of

"Self" is of highest value study of Self indicated, by ancient Vedic science is missing from the present day education.

Shiksha is one of the aspects of Veda so it is the Vedanga (Limb of Veda). Shiksha itself is more holistic word and conveys much broader meaning than the word "Education" especially in terms of education, which is prevalent in modern times.

Shiksha evolves the individual consciousness from his own-self to the Cosmic-self, in the sequence of Shiksha-Kalp-Vyakaran-Nirukta-Chanda-Jyotish, which are the six Vedangas. As explained in Vedic text "दूरे यं गृहपतिम अर्थपुम" which means that the individual experiences the outer world and gradually going further and further up to the cosmos realizes that everything seen outside is nothing but the reverberation of his own-self (Individual realizes the whole universe as expression and emerging from his own simplest form of awareness) as is Human Body so is creation (Universe) "Yatha Pinde Tatha Brahmande." Realizing the importance of consciousness, the Yoga departments in many Indian universities under the guidelines of UGC were extended to include Human Consciousness but what is needed most is to apply and impart these technologies for developing consciousness for the whole student community at large. Also the Yoga is mostly misunderstood as just physical Yogasanas and pranayam and not the real experience of "Self" in its simplest form of awareness through the most simple technique of Transcendental Meditation, which can be easily practiced by any one.

Scientists explore the hidden laws of nature. The laws of nature are innumerable infinite and even though it is not possible to remember all the laws of nature for all the time by anyone, while it is possible to tune our thought and actions to the laws of nature through the technologies of consciousness. Consciousness is the prime mover of life. All the thoughts and actions of every individual depend on the level of his consciousness. One's own self pure awareness "Atma" the fourth state of consciousness, which is different from the other three states-Waking, dreaming and sleeping and is completely peaceful without having any duality.

Knowledge: - Ideally knowledge has three aspects Adhyatmic, Adhidevik and Adhibhautik level, but modern education is not using the Adhyatmik and Adhidaivik level. As nowadays only Adhibhautik part of education is being given, it leads to bondage while if Total Knowledge (Adhyatmik, Adhidaivik and Adhibhautik) will be provided it will lead to fiulfillment, Bliss and freedom from bondage. Because Adhibhautik or Materialistic aspect of knowledge only encourages and leads everyone to demand everything from others at physical level. Even the great leaders come out on the road and shout slogans to achieve the demands. If the knowledge and Maharishi Technologies of Consciousness of seeking from the infinite source, the field of all possibilities, within one's own self is provided then these large number of people meditating and using the Maharishi Technologies of Consciousness together will one hand create peace in the whole environment and on the other hand infinite potential of nature will organize to achieve the desired objectives of all those people as well as is said ''क्रिया सिद्धि, सत्वेभवति महताम् नोपकरणे'' i.e., the success and achievement comes from "Sattva" or the purity of Consciousness and not just from material things.

The knowledge and experiences of the self, which should be given from the very childhood so that the student grows to become an ideal citizen living life in accordance with laws of nature leading to a happy, healthy and blissful life himself and creating harmony in the whole environment. Even in the field of Higher Education as well the situation is the same or even worse because more the individual goes deeper in the field of his discipline of study, more his knowledge is isolated from the holistic values of life. We try to bring the values in higher education without giving the highest knowledge, the knowledge and experience of one's own-Self as is said in Bhagwad-Geeta "अध्यात्मविद्या विद्यानां" In the field of knowledge the knowledge of self is most important or supreme.

पहार्षि ज्योतिष की हुन्डि में मार्च पाह

पंडित हरिशरण मिश्र (ज्योतिषाचार्य)



मार्च माह फाल्गुन कृष्ण पक्ष चतुर्थी दिन शुक्रवार से प्रारम्भ होकर चैत्र कृष्ण पक्ष चतुर्थी दिन रविवार पर्यन्त रहेगा। इस माह में पड़ने वाले विशिष्ट पर्व एवं त्यौहारों का माहात्म्य निम्नांकित है–

- 1. विजया एकादशी:— फाल्गुन कृष्ण एकादशी को विजया एकादशी कहते हैं। इस दिन भगवान् विष्णु की पूजा की जाती है, इस दिन व्रत को रखने से मनुष्य के दुःख, दारिद्र दूर होते है तथा समस्त कार्यों में विजय प्राप्त होती है इस व्रत को करने वाला व्यक्ति किसी कार्य में विफलता का मुँह नहीं देखता। कहते हैं फाल्गुन कृष्ण एकादशी के दिन भगवान् राम लंका पर आक्रमण करने के लिये समुद्र तट पर पहुँचे थे। जब समुद्र ने भगवान् श्री राम को उतरने का मार्ग नहीं दिया तब उन्होंने समुद्र तट पर निवास करने वाले ऋषियों से उपाय पूछा था। तब आपस में मंत्रणा करके ऋषियों ने कहा था कि हे राम! आप तो अनन्त सागरों को पार करने वाले सर्व शक्तिमान हैं फिर भी जब आपने पूछा है तो सुनिये, आप विजया एकादशी का व्रत कीजिये। इस व्रत के प्रभाव से समुद्र आपको रास्ता दे देगा और लंका पर विजय भी प्राप्त होगी, बस उसी दिन से इस व्रत का प्रचलन शुरू हो गया।
- 2. महा शिवरात्रि:— फाल्गुन कृष्ण चतुर्दशी को महाशिव रात्रि व्रत किया जाता है, यह भगवान् शिव का अत्यन्त महत्वपूर्ण व्रत है। इस दिन भगवान् शिव का षोडशोपचार पूजन करके अनेकानेक प्रकार से अभिषेक करना चाहिये तथा रात्रि को जागरण रखकर भगवान् शिव की प्रहर पूजा भी करनी चाहिये। दूध दही, मधु, शक्कर, पंचामृत आदि से भगवान् शिव का पूजन करके, भांग भी शिव जी को चढ़ानी चाहिये इसे विजया कहा जाता है विजया से भगवान् शिव का स्नान भी होता है।

<mark>इस व्रत से अभीष्ट मनोरथ की सिद्धि होती है तथा परिवार में सुख-शान्ति एवं समृद्धि आती है।</mark>

- 3. आमलकी एकादशी— फाल्गुन शुक्ल पक्ष की एकादशी को आमलकी एकादशी कहते हैं। आंवले के वृक्ष में भगवान का निवास होने के कारण इसी के नीचे भगवान विष्णु का पूजन करना चाहिये। इस एकादशी को व्रत रखकर आंवले का उबटन आंवला मिश्रित जल से स्नान, आंवला का पूजन, आंवला मिश्रित भोजन तथा आंवले का दान करना चाहिये।
- 4. होलिका पूजन एवं होलिका दहन— हमारे देश में दीपावली के समान ही यह त्यौहार सबसे अधिक धूमधाम और सर्वाधिक आनंद एवं उल्लास के साथ मनाया जाता है। यद्यपि समय के परिवर्तन एवं शिक्षा के प्रचार—प्रसार ने इसके साथ जुड़ी रंगों की बहार और गायन—वादन के कार्यक्रमों को काफी कम कर दिया है। फिर भी यह हमारा ऐसा सामाजिक पर्व है, जिसमें अमीर—गरीब, स्त्री—पुरुष, बालक—वृद्ध एवं जाति—पाति की दीवारें टूट जाती हैं।

यद्यपि होलिका दहन ही नहीं अपितु होलिका पूजन और होली के लिये गोबर की कण्डी की मालायें बनाना धर्मिक कृत्य है। महिलायें इस दिन व्रत भी रखती है।

होली फाल्गुन मास की पूर्णिमा की रात्रि में जलायी जाती है। ज्योतिष की दृष्टि में भद्रा में होली जलाना वर्जित है। यही कारण है कि किसी–किसी वर्ष यह पर्व शाम को मनाया जाता है तथा कभी–कभी रात्रि 2 बजे के आस–पास होलिका का दहन किया जाता है। किन्तु महिलाओं द्वारा सामृहिक होली पूजन दिन में दोपहर के बाद शाम तक ही की जाती है। महिलायें एक पात्र में जल, अक्षत, रोली, मौली तागा, अबीर, गुलाल एवं पकवान के सहित होलिका माता का पूजन करती हैं।

The assembly included distinguished international leaders and directors of Maharishi's programmes from countries around the world, and was also honoured by the presence of Indian spiritual leaders and other dignitaries, as well as directors and teachers of Maharishi's institutions in India.

India's fiscal budget 'realistic', positive for ratings - Moody's

India's budget for the next fiscal year offers a 'realistic' plan to meet the country's fiscal deficit target, and should be a credit positive for its sovereign ratings, Moody's Investor's Service said in a report. India's fiscal consolidation plans could pave the way for monetary easing, thus helping revive economic growth, Moody's also said about the budget unveiled last week.

Jaguar Land Rover studying full production in India - sources

Jaguar Land Rover (JLR) is investigating the potential of manufacturing cars in India, company sources said, as the British luxury carmaker looks to build on its growth in emerging markets with the help of Indian parent Tata Motors. JLR, which has ridden a wave of surging demand in China and other emerging markets to post record profits over the past year, is 'actively exploring the possibility' of building cars from scratch in India, said one company source.

Anshu Gupta brings 'clothing for dignity' to India

In 1998, Anshu Gupta decided to give up his business career to do something to address a basic need of the poor in India clothing. Gupta and his wife, Meenakshi, founded GOONJ, which means 'echo'. GOONJ is run almost entirely by volunteers across India who collect, sort, and distribute old clothes that people have given away. Nothing is given away free of charge; Gupta's motto is 'clothing for dignity', and he has also put in place a Cloth for Work programme across the rural areas where GOONJ has a presence. If a piece of cloth cannot be used as clothing, it is processed and converted into something that can be sold, such as a bag, quilt, or yoga mat. As of now, 2.2 million pounds of material are processed annually by GOONJ.

Thousands from India & Bangladesh celebrate Mother Language Day

With thousands of people from either side of the border gathering at colourful functions to commemorate the 'language martyrs', India and Bangladesh jointly organized the International Mother Language Day. Women and young students of both nations joined the celebrations Wednesday, breached borders and walked deep into the other country's territory as artists from the two sides performed dances and sang songs.

India's rice revolution

In a village in India's poorest state, Bihar, farmers are growing world record amounts of rice with no genetically modified seeds and no herbicide. Sumant Kumar was overjoyed when he harvested his rice last year. Kumar, a shy young farmer in Nalanda district, had using only farmyard manure and without any

herbicides grown an astonishing 22.4 tonnes of rice on one hectare of land. This was a world record and with rice the staple food of more than half the world's population of seven billion, big news. Other farmers in his district had astonishing yields as well. Nobel prize-winning economist Joseph Stiglitz visited Nalanda district and recognised the potential of this kind of organic farming, telling the villagers they were 'better than scientists'.

India: The Kumbh Mela experience improves well-being research shows

Research at the Kumbh Mela found that the event 'actually increases peoples' mental and physical well-being', showing the 'importance of networks and groups in sustaining our health'. The pilgrims, the study says, reported better well-being after the Mela compared to a sample of people who did not attend it.

India's rice revolution - audio slideshow

Farmers in parts of India are breaking growing records, using less seed, less water, and compost as fertilizer. This ground-breaking method of cultivation, developed in Madagascar, is boosting yields and changing lives for the farmers. Norman Uphoff, professor at Cornell University, explains how it is done.

Near the end of a comprehensive lecture about the dangers of genetically modified food, Dr. Peter Swan, an expert in Maharishi Vedic Organic Agriculture, described two organic farming methods that provide solutions to the needs of modern agriculture and food production. Both are 'no-till' methods that are not only simple but also save time, energy, and money, and are less damaging to the environment. The supreme level of nutrition and vital food for health, Dr. Swan said, is Maharishi Vedic Organic food. Vedic technologies, applied at each of the eight stages of the crops' growth, enliven the total organizing intelligence of nature for a thoroughly life-enhancing effect.

Why are MUM Computer Science graduates in high demand?

There are a number of reasons that graduates of the MS in Computer Science (Computer Professionals) degree programme at Maharishi University of Management go on to find success as working professionals, said department chair Dr. Keith Levi, mentioning a few: 'One, we are quite selective who we admit,' he said. She studied at MUM's partner university, the Overseas Chinese College of the Capital University of Economics and Business in Beijing, then enrolled at MUM in Fairfield, Iowa, USA. Yali completed her BA in business administration in 2010, receiving the Outstanding Student Award, and continued in the part-time MBA in Sustainable Business, while working in the Art Department. 'I like the concept of Consciousness-Based Education,' she says. 'The first thing a school should teach you is how to be yourself.'

Maharishi University of Management launching six new master's degree programmes

The success of several undergraduate programmes that have had strong interest among undergraduate students has inspired Maharishi University of Management to launch master's degrees in these same areas. These include: Maharishi Vedic Science, Media and Communications, Sustainable Living, and Integrative Health. In addition, materials are now being prepared for an online MBA, and planning is underway to offer the M.S. in Computer Science via distance education. The ultimate goal is eventually to offer half a dozen MA programs online via distance education.

Transcendence: Author explains central concept of bestselling book
