महर्षि ज्योतिष की दृष्टि में नवम्बर माह

पण्डित हरिशरण मिश्र, (ज्योतिषाचार्य)



नवम्बर माह कार्तिक कृष्ण पक्ष तृतीया दिन गुरुवार से प्रारम्भ होकर मार्गशीर्ष कृष्ण पक्ष द्वितीया दिन शुक्रवार पर्यन्त रहेगा।

इस माह में पड़ने वाले विशिष्ट पर्व एवं त्यौहारों का माहात्म्य निम्नांकित है —

करक चतुर्थी (करवा चौथ) — यह व्रत कार्तिक कृष्णपक्ष की चन्द्रोदय व्यापिनी चतुर्थी को किया जाता है। इस व्रत में शिव-पार्वती, कार्तिकेय और चन्द्रमा का पूजन करना चाहिये। नैवेद्य में मिट्टी के बने पात्र (करवे) लड्डू अर्पण करने चाहिये। इस व्रत को विशेषकर सौभाग्यवती स्त्रियां अथवा उसी वर्ष में विवाही हुई लड़कियां करती हैं। सुख सौभाग्य पुत्र पौत्रादि एवं स्थिर लक्ष्मी की प्राप्ति के लिये भी यह व्रत किया जाता है। शिव-पार्वती एवं कार्तिकेय के पूजन के बाद नैवेद्य एवं दक्षिणा ब्राह्मण को देकर चन्द्र देव का दर्शन करके उनको अर्घ्य देना चाहिये।

धन त्रयोदशी — कार्तिक कृष्ण त्रयोदशी को सायंकाल के समय एक दीपक प्रज्वलित करें उस दीपक का गन्धादि से पूजन करके अपने मकान के द्वार पर अन्न (गेहूँ, चावल) की ढेरी रखकर उस पर दीपक को रखना चाहिये, स्मरण रहे कि वह दीपक रातभर जलते रहना चाहिये, उसे बुझना नहीं चाहिये। ऐसी सुरक्षा करके रखना चाहिये।

इसी दिन धनवन्तरि जयंती भी मनायी जाती है। इसमें औषधियों के प्रदाता धनवन्तरि भगवान की पूजा अर्चना की जाती है।

नरक चतुर्दशी — कार्तिक कृष्ण चतुर्दशी को नरक चतुर्दशी भी कहते हैं। इस दिन प्रदोष काल के समय तिल के तैल से परिपूर्ण चौदह दीपक जलाकर उन दीपकों की गन्धादि से पूजन करके ब्रह्मा, विष्णु एवं महेशादि के मंदिर, मठ, परकोटा, बाग, बगीचे, गली, गौशाला इत्यादि स्थानों में स्थापित करना चाहिये। साथ ही एक दीपक अलग से जलाकर, उस पर चारों दिशाओं की तरफ चार बत्तियां जलाना चाहिये फिर मकान से दक्षिण भाग में उस दीपक को रखना चाहिये। ऐसा करने से यमराज प्रसन्न होते हैं और उस जीव को नरक यातना नहीं भोगनी पड़ती है। ऐसा शास्त्रों में उल्लेख आया है।

गोवर्धन पूजा — दीपावली के दूसरे दिन प्रातः काल गाय के गोबर से गोवर्धन पर्वत बनाना चाहिये, इसे शिखर शाखादि से संयुक्त और पुष्प इत्यादि लगाकर अच्छे ढंग से सजा देना चाहिये। फिर गन्धाक्षतादि से विधिवत पूजा करने का विधान है। शाम के समय इन्हीं गोवर्धन के पास ले जाकर गायों की भी पूजन करना चाहिये। फिर अगले दिन या इसी दिन गोवर्धन के निमित्त छप्पन प्रकार के षड्रस व्यंजन बनाकर उनको नैवेद्य अर्पण करना चाहिये। तदपश्चात् अपने कुटुम्ब जनों के साथ आपस में मिल-जुल कर उस प्रसाद को खाना चाहिये। यह गोवर्धन पूजन एक प्रकार से भगवान कृष्ण की ही पूजा है।

यम द्वितीया — कार्तिक शुक्ल द्वितीया को यम का पूजन किया जाता है। इससे यह यम द्वितीया कहलाती है। इस दिन व्यापारी लोग व्यापारिक पात्रादि का पूजन भी करते हैं। इसलिये इसे कलमदान पूजा भी कहा जाता है। इस दिन भाई अपनी बहन के घर जाकर भोजन करते हैं। इसलिये यह भईया दूज के नाम से भी विख्यात है। भईया दूज को बहिन के घर भोजन करने से भाई की आयु में वृद्धि होती है तथा बहिन के सौभाग्य की वृद्धि होती है। ऐसा शास्त्रों में कहा गया है।

India: Over 2,000 peace-creating experts established, eventual goal is 9,000

In a speech in Chicago, business leader Dr. Ramani Ayer described to the large, mainly Indo-American audience the progress in realizing Maharishi Mahesh Yogi's goal to establish and permanently sustain a group of 9,000 Vedic Pandits-peace-creating experts-in the Brahmsthan (centre) of India. Practising Maharishi's technologies of consciousness, this group will create an effect of coherence powerful enough to transform the violent, negative trends of the world to a state of lasting peace. Dr. Ayer, the former Chairman and CEO of The Hartford Financial Services Group, described the stages of building up the group from its current size of over 2,000 first to 3,500, then 5,000, and finally 9,000-with corresponding greater positive effects for India and the world.

India: Nifty over 5,900, first time since April 2011

The BSE Sensitive Index and Nifty (National Stock Exchange Nifty) gained on Wednesday for the sixth time in seven sessions on hopes the government will muster a majority in parliament on a crucial vote to allow foreign direct investment in multi-brand retail later in the day. Shares in organized retailers such as Pantaloon Retail India Ltd. and Shoppers Stop rallied on hopes of a favourable vote for the government.

India: Factory index accelerates to five-month high in November

India's manufacturing sector beat the expectations of economists to grow at its fastest pace in five months in November, boosted by strong export orders and a surge in output, a business survey showed on Monday. The new export orders sub-index rose to a six-month high of 55.9 in November, giving thrust to overall orders and factory output, both of which expanded at their fastest pace since July.

India: Sensitive Index ends near 19,200; highest since April 2011

The BSE Sensex surged on Thursday to close at its highest in 19 months after the government agreed to a vote in parliament on allowing foreign entry in multi-brand retail, raising hopes that key reforms will pass through. Shares were further boosted after Goldman Sachs upgraded Indian stocks to 'overweight' from 'market-weight', citing growth recovery and inflation moderation ahead. The investment bank pegged the December 2013 Nifty target at 6,600 points.

India: Bangalore emerging as a major city of 'organic brands'

Bio Fach India, an offshoot of World Organic Trade Fair Bio Fach in Nurnberg, plans to hold its organic fair in Bangalore. The fourth edition of Bio Fach India 2012 by Nuremberg Messe is supported by the Karnataka Department of Agriculture and the International Competence Centre for Organic Agriculture (ICCOA). 'The fair is to facilitate organic production, manufacturing, trade and it is the single platform where various stake-holders in the organic value chain congregate to network,' said International Competence Centre for Organic Agriculture (ICCOA) Executive Director Manoj Kumar Menon.

India: Khalsa College in Amritsar begins organic farming

Khalsa College Amritsar (KCA) is converting a major share of its 200 acres farmland into organic farming. On Friday, the sowing of wheat started at the farm where only organic farming would be adopted and no insecticides, pesticides, and fertilizers would be used, said Khalsa College Governing Council (KCGC) functionaries.

Myanmar's Suu Kyi meets with top leaders in India

Myanmar opposition leader Aung San Suu Kyi met with India's Prime Minister Manmohan Singh and Foreign Secretary Ranjan Mathai on Wednesday as part of a trip to establish closer ties between the countries. Suu Kyi also visited the memorials of Indian independence leaders Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi and Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru on Wednesday, and delivered the prestigious Nehru Memorial Lecture, held annually to mark the birthday of independent India's first elected leader.

India: Healing Kashmir's wounds

Until recently the roar of guns and bombs drowned out all sounds but now a cacophony of melodies from guitar and drums is sweeping Kashmir's war-weary youngsters with a message of love and peace. These days, as violence has decreased significantly since India and Pakistan began a peace process in 2004, the militants' hold over daily life in the valley has eased. The sound of a rock band is soothing in Kashmir, which was otherwise an easygoing society but has been blighted by decades of violence. Traditional theatre and music are also being revived.

Govt approves scheme for setting up 20 IITs in partnership with private sector (Press Trust of India)

New Delhi: The government has approved a scheme for setting up 20 IITs in PPP mode with an overall outlay of Rs. 2,808.71 crore, the Lok-Sabha was informed on Wednesday. In a written reply, Union Minister of State for HRD, Shri Shashi Tharoor said, "While land for the purpose would be made available free of cost by state governments concerned, an IIT would be established at a capital cost of Rs. 128 crore each to be contributed in ratio of 50:35:15 by centre, state and industry partner respectively."

On entry of corporate sector in technical education, he said, "AICTE has allowed public/private limited company/industries with Rs. 100 crore turnover for last three years to establish a new technical institution in engineering and technology, pharmacy, architecture and town planning, hotel management and catering technology."

Replying to a separate question on pending cases of new IITs, he said, "Based on the recommendations of Scientific Advisory Council to the Prime Minister and also having regard to the regional imbalance, government during 11th Five Year Plan established eight new IITs."

These institutes were opened in Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Rajasthan, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh. "Proper connectivity, physical infrastructure and basic facilities have been kept in view while deciding locations for setting up these IITs,"
